For Immediate Release: County Commission District 6 candidate Shirley Allenbrand officially kicked off her campaign for the general election this week with an announcement. Allenbrand, a lifetime Republican and longtime Olathe civic leader raised \$35K for her first report at the end of July.

“Shirley’s hard work and amazing volunteer support makes her a very viable candidate in November,” said JoLinda Vega, Campaign Chair for Allenbrand.

Allenbrand’s fundraising topped all six candidates remaining for the three county commission seats in the general election.

“Shirley has great leadership skills; she will listen and work with her colleagues on the commission. She will be a wonderful commissioner,” stated former Governor and business partner, Mark Parkinson.

Shirley was born and raised in Olathe, where her father was president of the Optimist Club, and Fred Allenbrand ran for and was re-elected Sheriff when the city had just 15,000 residents. Over the years, Shirley has served on the board of Heart to Heart International (1992 airlift), the Olathe Audit Committee, went door-to-door to help launch Olathe Health, served on the Olathe Chamber and TLC Boards, graduated from Leadership Olathe, and currently serves on the Olathe Planning Commission.

She has been recognized as a leader in health care, housing, and business by various chambers of commerce and industry groups throughout the county and was one of the first women in the Olathe Rotary Club and the Optimist Club.
